Disclosure Statement for Financial Aid Regulation (34 CFR 666.42)

The associate degree nursing program at Labette Community College meets the state education requirements for a practical and registered nursing license in the state of Kansas. Labette Community College has not determined if the practical and associate degree nursing program at Labette Community College meets the state education requirements in any other state, any U.S. Territory, or the District of Columbia. The National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) has resources that may be helpful. The NCSBN website, <https://www.ncsbn.org> contains a link to every Nursing Practice Act. FAQ regarding the impact of 34 CFR 668.43 on nursing programs, and a webpage for every State Regulatory Agency for Nursing.

Nurses are required to be licensed in the state where the patient is located at the time service is provided.

A multistate license allows the nurse to practice in all compact states/territories with one license issued by the home state of Kansas.

This eliminates the costly and time-consuming process of obtaining multiple single-state licenses when practicing with patients located in multiple NLC states.

The Nurse Licensure Compact Licensure Requirements for a Multi-State License is part of the NLC to meet licensure requirements as per K.S.A. 65-1166.
