Labette Community College is offering a course designed for individuals who operate, or are planning to operate, facilities that have been provisionally licensed or expect to be licensed by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.

This course is required for non-licensed administrators of the following facilities:

- Assisted Living (with fewer than 61 residents)
- Residential Health Care (with fewer than 61 residents)
- Home Plus
- Adult Day Care

A Labette Community College Certificate of Completion will be issued to participants upon successful completion of the course (including passing the state test), and a roster of those participants will be sent to K.D.H.E.
