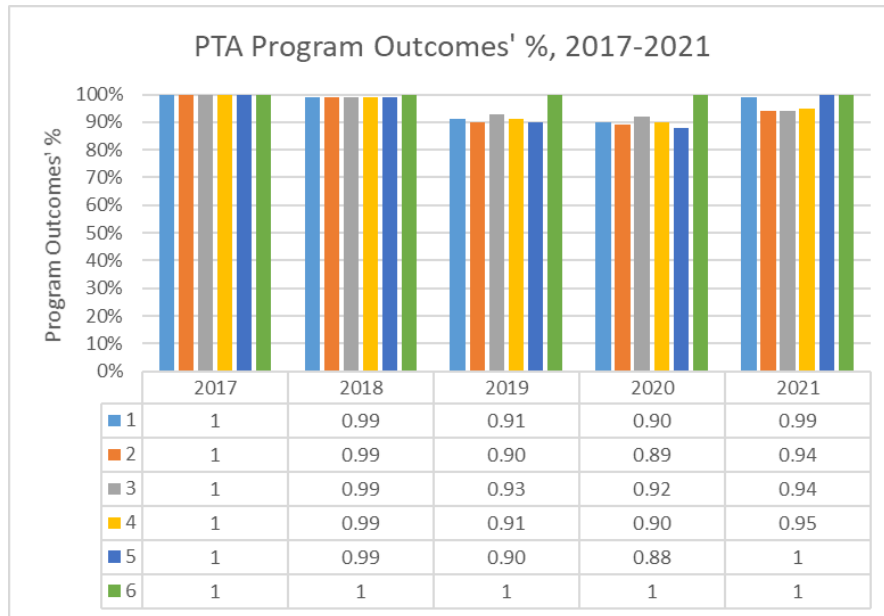


Physical Therapy Assistant

*CAPTE accreditation requires 85% ultimate pass rate over 2 years. The program is currently on probation due to two-year sum being below the required 85% requirement.
