PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA

Goal: The program will graduate entry-level radiologic technologists.

ARRT EXAMINATION PASS RATE

Student Learning Outcome: Graduates will pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography examination.

Benchmark: 90% of graduates will pass their national certification examination on their first attempt.

Analysis: The average pass rate for the past five years was 96%. The rate exceeds the benchmark of 90%.

JOB PLACEMENT RATE

Student Learning Outcome: Graduates within twelve months were able to find employment as a radiographer.

Benchmark: Of the graduates returning their graduate surveys, 75% of those seeking employment as a radiographer were able to find employment.

Analysis: The five year employment rate of 86% exceeds the benchmark of 75% for those students returning their graduate surveys.

PROGRAM COMPLETION RATE

Student Learning Outcome: Program completion rates.

Benchmark: 75% of the students entering the program will graduate from the program.

Analysis: The five year program completion rate of 72% fails to meet the benchmark of 75%.

****Standards 2014** Explanation of Program completion rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who complete the program within 150% of stated program length.

The program defines the entry point as the final date to drop with 100% tuition refund which is the same date for the official class roster deadline during students first fall semester in the program. Students who leave or do not graduate on time for *any reason*, such as medical leave, personal choice, or course failure, after the stated entry point are considered as not completing the program with the original cohort.

****** Students must maintain at least an overall grade point average of 2.0 or letter grade of a “C”. All radiography courses must be a grade of “C” (90% - 86%) or better.
