



2026-2027 Entrance Exam

All prospective applicants must pass the entrance exam before gaining access to the full program application. Please review the information below carefully:

1. Exam Format:

The exam consists of 50 multiple-choice questions and covers the following subject areas:

- Anatomy & Physiology (40–50%): Includes topics such as body directions, organ systems, and circulation.
- Medical Terminology (20–25%): Focuses on prefixes, suffixes, and foundational medical vocabulary.
- Patient Care (25–35%): Covers infection control, patient safety, and general clinical practices.

2. Passing Requirement:

A minimum score of 80% is required to pass.

3. Attempts Allowed:

Applicants are allowed up to two attempts.

- Each attempt requires a \$50 non-refundable fee.

4. Availability:

The exam will be available beginning October 1, 2025.

5. Registration Process:

6. Proctoring & Exam Access:

The exam is proctored online.
