

Securing a Clinical Site

Clinical Observation

Applicants are required to participate in an 8-hour observation day at the site where they wish to complete their rotation. During the observation, applicants will need to share the link provided in the application with the credentialed sonographer to assess the prospective sonography student.

After the Observation

Once LCC receives the evaluation, we will contact the site to discuss the possibility of hosting you for the rotation. If they agree, we will start the affiliate agreement process. Should the site choose not to host you, you will need to restart the observation process at a different clinical site.

After the agreement has been approved and signed, the clinical site will be considered "secured."

Applicants must be able to secure their own clinical site before the March 11, 2025 deadline to be considered for the interview stage.
