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## Accuplacer Study App

1. Create a free account at <https://accuplacerpractice.collegeboard.org/login>

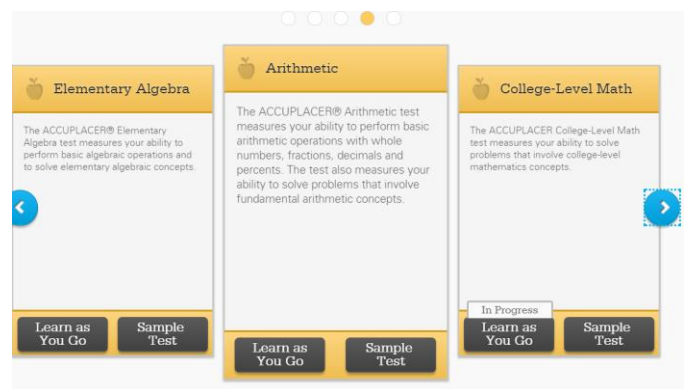
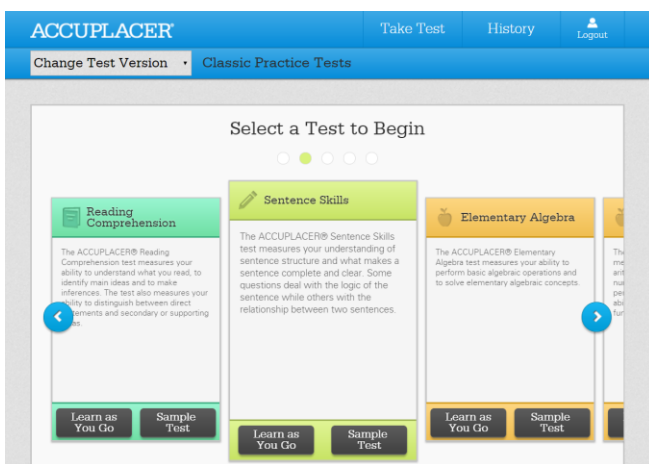

### 3. Which skills assessments should you complete?

- For placement in Comp I, start with the 'Sentence Skills' test. If you have difficulty scoring at least 70% on the Sample Test, you should also review the 'Reading Comprehension' test.
- For placement in College Algebra, start by reviewing basic fraction and decimal rules in the Arithmetic module then move on to Elementary Algebra and College-Level Math.
- Remember that you are not allowed to use a calculator unless you are provided a calculator on the screen. This means that you need to be prepared to do basic operations by hand (i.e. addition, subtraction, multiplication, long division and fraction manipulation).



- ### 4. Choosing 'Learn as You Go' allows you to view the correct answer and explanation after each question. Choose 'Sample Test' if you want to complete all your questions before reviewing your score (this option is most like the actual test).

#### **Points to Remember:**

- There will be questions that you don't know how to do. Don't sweat it.
- There is no time limit.
- You can test up to 2 times every enrollment period. (Each period begins April 1 and November 1.)
