Comments:

Upon completion of the program, students will be eligible to complete licensing exams. Successful completion of the exams will award a Kansas occupational license and the NREMT certification. The NREMT must be renewed every two years to remain active. NREMT is the basis of reciprocity; graduates must maintain their registry to gain credentials in other States. A limited number of States participate in the Recognition of EMS Personnel Licensure Interstate CompAct (REPLICA).

Qualified EMS professionals licensed in a "Home State" are extended "Privilege to Practice" in Remote States for qualified circumstances. This may allow graduates with lapsed NREMT to gain licensure in other States without acurrent NREMT status. Information regarding EMS Compact and the Interstate Commission for EMS Personnel Practice is available at www.EMSCompact.gov. Program applicants should consult with state agencies to determine stae licensure requirements.
