SUBJECT

Approval of Student COVID Vaccination Incentive

REASON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE BOARD

College Policy states that the Board of Trustees' approval is normally required for items costing in excel of \$19,999.

BACKGROUND

The Higher Education Emergency Relief funds may be used as an incentive to promote student COVID vaccinations. We would like to offer \$250 scholarships for any student taking on-ground classes during the fall 2021 semester that provides proof of full vaccination. This scholarship will be applied to their spring semester. If the student has completed their degree or certificate program at the end of the fall 2021 semester, the scholarship would be applied to their fall bill. Students will also be eligible for a drawing for \$1,000. Five student names will be drawn on main campus and one student name will be drawn at Cherokee campus.

PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION

The President recommends the Board of Trustees approve a \$250 scholarship incentive for all fully vaccinated student taking classes on-ground in the fall of 2020, as well as the drawings for \$1000 for six eligible students.
