

# **Equipment Operator Trainee**

The Equipment Operator positions require a Class A CDL with Air Brake option and Tanker Endorsement at the time of hire. If you do not currently have a Class A CDL but are still interested in employment with the Kansas Department of Transportation, you may still qualify for our Equipment Operator Trainee program which is a paid position that provides employees with on-the-job training while you work towards obtaining a CDL. **KDOT provides CDL training at no cost to the employee**. You may apply for either Equipment Operator or Equipment Operator Trainee roles.

## Job Responsibilities may include but are not limited to the following:

- Perform manual labor associated with maintenance activities, including the operation of miscellaneous equipment such as chain saws, weed eaters, pumps, compressors, jackhammers, generators, power tools, and various hand tools.
- Setup and remove temporary traffic control and serve as flag person for maintenance work zones.
- Maintain highways and facilities through activities such as repairs, resurfacing, mowing, and snow and ice control.
- Operate dump trucks, small and medium-size loaders, mowers, tractors, rollers, and power brooms to perform various maintenance tasks. Operate a loader or truck-mounted plow and spreader in snow and ice control operations.
- On-the-job training is provided.

Without Class A CDL: Equipment Operator Trainee

- Base Annual Salary: \$38,979.20
- Base Hourly Pay: \$18.74

- Valid Driver's License at time of appointment.
- **Preferred Requirements** 
  - Class A Commercial Driver's License with Air Brake option and Tanker Endorsement at time of appointment.

• A CDL must be obtained within 90 days of hire and maintained. KDOT provides CDL training at no cost to employees.
